

Greater Week 6 Study Questions

Read 1 Peter 5:1-3.

POINT 1 - LEAD AS A WITNESS OF CHRIST

Look up and discuss some of the ups and downs Peter experienced in the Gospels.

How do the struggles Peter experienced empower him to share the Gospel with others?

What do witnesses do? How does being a witness bring honor and glory to Christ?

POINT 2 - LEAD AS A DISCIPLE OF CHRIST

In verse 2, how does Peter describe positive and negative examples of leadership?

Why would a consistent, life-giving relationship with Christ enable us to serve willingly and eagerly?

When you aren't closely walking with Christ, how does that typically affect the way you serve?

POINT 3 - LEAD AS A FOLLOWER OF CHRIST

Read Matthew 20:25-28 and 1 Peter 5:3.

How do Jesus' and Peter's views of leadership differ from the world's view?

What makes it hard to lead by example/as a servant?

Leaders must repeat this process daily. How does each step lead to the next?

Witness (Preach the Gospel to themselves) -> Disciple (Enjoy Relationship with God) -> Follow (Obey)

Read Ephesians 5:1-2

How does the message in these two verses compare with the one in 1 Peter?
